Second Vote on the BREXIT and Remain!

The AGS Hessen-South, in its board meeting of January 16, 2019, urges all political parties in the United Kingdom but in particular its sister party LABOUR with its SME4Labour division to pave the way for a second referendum on the BREXIT. This will strengthen democracy as it allows the population to have fresh look at the issues in a much better-informed way. The aim of that second vote in our opinion must be that LABOUR, as a traditionally internationalist political force, fully supports a “Remain” position.
